




#### RENOVATIONS






#### THE WINE CELLAR

Similarly to Coral Reef, Sandpiper has also completely renovated the gym, glassed to overlook the garden and creating a much improved setting along with some new equipment.








#### BRITISH AIRWAYS

Enjoy regular flights from London Gatwick - Bridgetown.
